Scottish Government	Review of National Care Standards	Spring 2014	The National Care Standards help people who receive care understand what to expect from services, and services understand the standards they should deliver. There are currently 23 sets of standards covering a wide range of care services, from childminders and nurseries to care homes and independent hospitals. There have been many changes since the standards were created in 2002 and the Scottish Government is seeking views on how standards should be updated and improved to meet current expectations and models of service delivery. One of the proposals is that people working in health and care services should have a common understanding of what quality means and work to common core values, through the introduction of quality standards for health and care services.
