3. Site and Design Considerations

- 3.1 Wigtown Community Council had discussed siting issues and the bus stop / bus shelter issue. This is being addressed but will take some time to resolve. WCC agreed the switch of site to the town gardens gateway opposite the County Buildings.
- 3.2 Jack Sloan presented three proposals for an archway at the gates as a setting for the commemorative paving stone, and for the town garden re-naming. The proposals drew inspiration from the County Buildings architecture, a garden theme, and Military symbolism. All involved a square style of "archway" in steel which is easier and less expensive to construct, and more in keeping with the style of the town centre and its conservation status than a curved arch. He suggests cut out lettering and a three-dimensional effect in the design to give the entrance way depth, with the "archway" set between the substantial granite gate posts and the flag poles. Costs are not yet assessed.
- 3.3 Agreed all excellent proposals, and at this stage all three to be developed for further consultation. Drawings to be made up to level for public consultation / information session, and to share with Planning for feedback. (Jack)
- 3.4 Billy Murray to be updated, and invited to next meeting. (Nick)
