CURRENT CONSULTATIONS

- a) **Local Development Plan (LDP2)** – Dumfries & Galloway Council. Closing date: ~~26-March 2018~~ Now Monday, 30 April 2018
The Council adopted the current LDP in September 2014 and it's reviewed every five years to keep it up to date. LDP2 should be in place by September 2019 and the Council are now preparing the new version.
Nick Walker suggested a representation on Open Space but the relative Supplementary Guidance 'Part 3 Open Space Settlement Account and Part 4 Protected areas of Open Space' will not be reviewed and updated until after the adoption of LDP 2. The Council "recognise" Open Space in the Main Issues Report but it is "not considered a Main issue".
- b) **Review of Scheme for the Establishment of Community Councils** – Dumfries & Galloway Council. Closing date: Friday, 30 March 2018
A draft response to the third phase of the review has been prepared and circulated. Issues covered include feedback on specific areas of the Scheme of Establishment: Format; Code of Conduct; Elections, Minimum Numbers.
- c) **Parental Satisfaction Survey for Schools 2018** - Dumfries & Galloway Council. Closing date: Friday, 30 March 2018.
A short online survey that allows **parents** to have their say on DGC schools, the aspects which they feel are handled well and those which they think could be further improved. There are 10 statements where respondents are asked to indicate the level of their agreement/disagreement
