- a) **Spaces for People Dumfries and Galloway** – Sustrans Scotland **Closing date:** 21 August 2020
Sustrans Scotland are working in partnership with Dumfries and Galloway Council to deliver the Spaces for People programme. In the coming months our town centres need to prioritise and enable safe physical distancing to support local businesses and residents to stay safe by limiting transmission of COVID-19. Sustrans want to encourage people to walk, cycle or wheel at a safe physical distance from others, avoiding unnecessary car journeys.

To ensure that as many people as possible have the opportunity to share their views they have set up a [website](#), where comments and suggestions about creating temporary space for walking and cycling can be posted. While it may not be possible to address every issue that is suggested, the Council will use the site to prioritise their work and try to direct its limited resources to where they are most needed.
